ABOUT THE ASSOCIATION

HISTORY

The Bengal Library Association, formerly known as, All Bengal Library Association was established in Calcutta on 20th December, 1925 under the presidentship of **Rabindranath Tagore** and the first secretary of the Association was Mr. Sushil Kumar Ghosh. This decision was prompted out of a resolution for formation of library associations in each province of India adopted in the 3rd All India Public Library Conference held at Belgaon, Karnataka in 1924 under the presidentship of Deshbandhu Chittaranjan Das. With the establishment of All Bengal Library Association, a provincewise library movement started gaining grounds.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Association include:

For Libraries:

- Advocate for improvement and expansion of library services throughout the state;
- Promote the importance of libraries to the public and policymakers;
- ➤ Support the development of legislation that benefits libraries, and communities;
- ➤ Technology Integration: Supporting the integration of technology into library services and operations to enhance access to information and improve user experiences.

For Librarians:

- Provide continuing education and professional development opportunities;
- Advocate for fair wages, benefits, and working conditions for librarians;
- ➤ Foster collaboration and networking among librarians across the state.

Generally:

Promote of Literacy and Lifelong Learning: Promoting literacy initiatives and lifelong learning opportunities through libraries, including programs for children, teens, adults, and underserved populations.

Engage with Community:

➤ Encouraging libraries to engage with their communities through outreach programs, partnerships with local organizations, and innovative programming that meets the diverse needs of residents.

Overall, the objective is to strengthen the role of libraries as vital community resources and to support the professionals who work within them.

ACTIVITIES

The Association works to:

- Promote the value of libraries: This includes highlighting the importance of library and information services for individuals and society, and raising awareness of these services:
- Advocate for library improvement: The Association suggests measures to improve and expand library services for all types of libraries in the state;
- Support library workers: It works to improve the working conditions, pay, and overall status of library professionals;
- ➤ Provide professional development: It offers training courses, refresher courses, workshops, and lectures for library professionals. Additionally, they publish books, periodicals, and reports related to library science and services.

ACHIEVEMENTS

The key milestones of the Association's journey:

- ➤ Played a key role in designing and enacting the 'West Bengal Public Libraries Act, 1979', which established a legal framework for public library systems in the state;
- ➤ Providing training for library professionals since 1937 through its 'Certificate Course in Library Science';
- ➤ Upskilling the Workforce: Organizing refresher courses and orientation programs for working librarians in West Bengal at the request of government agencies;
- Modernizing Libraries: Implemented the Koha Library Management System (LMS) in 170 town libraries across West Bengal, following a government request;
- ➤ Global Recognition: Became a Global Support Provider for Koha LMS, demonstrating their expertise to the international library community;
- ➤ Installed Koha LMS in over 200 libraries across India and Bangladesh, serving prestigious institutions like Victoria Memorial Hall, Ritwik Memorial Library (Nandan), Gurudas College, West Bengal Public Service Commission Library, Patuakhali Science & Technology University Library, Bangladesh, etc.;
- Preserving Knowledge: Engaged in retro-conversion, a process of converting library catalogs from physical formats to digital ones, ensuring long-term access to information;
- Sharing Knowledge: Offers training programs on the Koha LMS to equip librarians with the latest technologies;
- National Collaboration: Maintains a Union Catalogue, a central database listing library collection across the country, facilitating resource sharing among libraries (weblibnet.blacal.org/vufind/).

This year, the Association will reach its hundred years of glorious journey on 20th December, 2024. Starting from this day upto 20th December, 2025, the Association has planned to celebrate its glorious journey through organization of different seminars/conferences, publishing centenary volume and other publications, organizing book talks and lectures,

felicitating renowned persons in the field of library and information science; and the like. We cordially invite everyone to participate actively in this upcoming celebration. Your full support, both moral and financial, is instrumental in ensuring the grand success of these programs.






